Salt Museum. Learn the traditional salt foam making process which is typical of Fuerteventura and its quality is excellent.

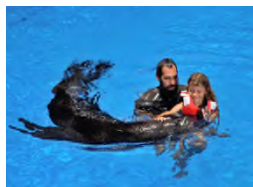
